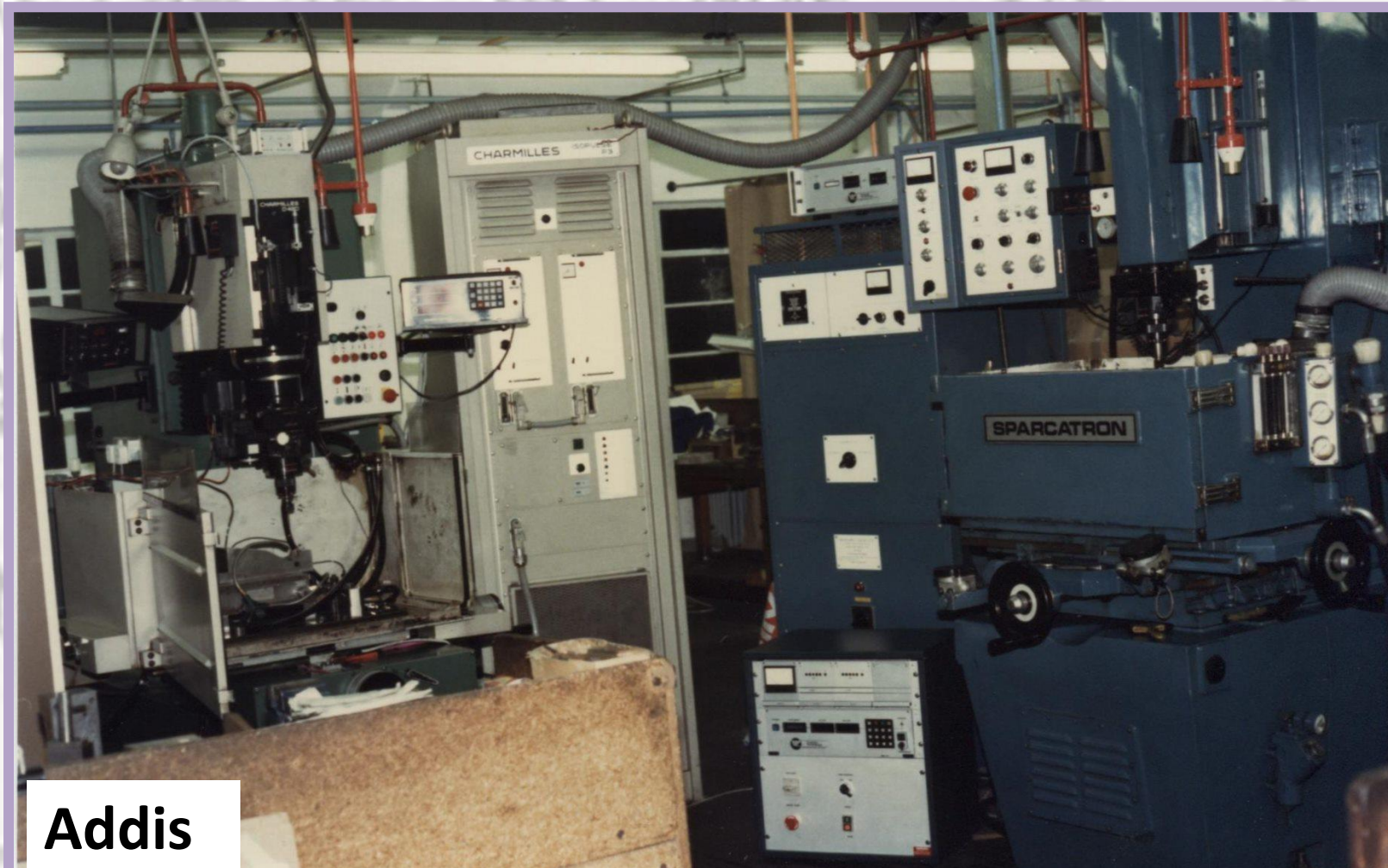
What was it like in the workplace?
